**RECIPES from Missionary
 Linda Moore, Philippines**

Chicken Binakol

600 g. chicken, cut into serving portions
 1 medium onion, sliced
 6 cloves garlic, crushed
 4 stalks tanglad (lemon grass)
 1 can(227g.) Del Monte tomato sauce
 2 small potatoes quartered

Place all ingredients in a casserole or saucepan. Stir in 1 1/4 cup water and 1 Tablespoon rock salt. Simmer for 35 minutes, or until cooked. Makes 6 servings.

Chicken and Pork Adobo

1 cup native vinegar
 1 head garlic, crushed
 1/2 teaspoon black pepper
 1 bay leaf (optional)

1 Tablespoon rock salt
 1/4 Tablespoon soy sauce
 1 Chicken, cut up
 1/2 kilo pork, cut into 1x2 pieces
 A slice of pork liver, cut into 1x2 pieces (optional)
 1 1/2 - 2 cups water
 cooking oil for frying

In a saucepan, combine vinegar, garlic, pepper, bay leaf, rock salt and soy sauce. Put in chicken, pork and liver. Let soak for 20-30 minutes. Add water and simmer uncovered until tender. Strain sauce. Set aside. If desired, chop liver finely. Combine with sauce. Set aside. Brown garlic, chicken and pork in cooking oil. Return everything to sauce pan, cover and simmer until sauce thickens.
